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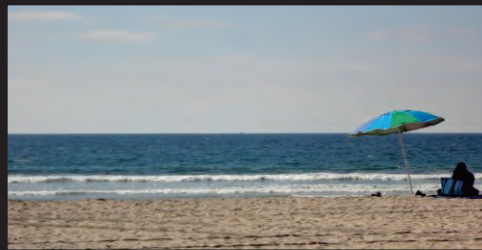

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In the 1930s, this beach was used as a surfing test ground for mainlanders going to Hawaii. The four 16-20 foot tall surfboard-shaped arches are believed to be the largest acrylic moldings ever cast.

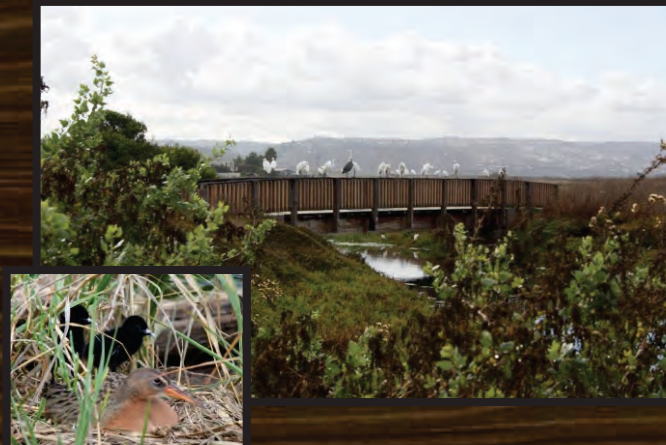


Imperial Beach Pier Plaza
